GENERAL INFORMATION

Coastal Center for Developmental Services, Inc. is a private, non-profit 501(c)(3) agency that provides training and employment-related services to more than 300 individuals with developmental disabilities.

With the mission of empowering adults with developmental disabilities to make life choices, CCDS is dedicated to the rights and responsibilities of full community citizenship. This is achieved through education, advocacy, services and supports, and driven by individual choice.

CCDS and its subsidiary corporation, Quantum, Inc., have been active parts in the Savannah community for more than 35 years. In the past decade, CCDS has become a leading force in the state by providing quality services to people with disabilities.

SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT SERVICES (QUANTUM, INC.)

Quantum, Inc. (the CCDS subsidiary) is a supported employment program providing integrated work to individuals with developmental disabilities. This employment option may be selected by persons receiving services and their families. Quantum operates with a sub-minimum wage certificate authorized by the Department of Labor.

Quantum offers four areas of training which provide real work experience:

- Quantum Catering
- Quantum Packaging Assembly
- Quantum Printing
- Quantum Specialized Assembly

COMMUNITY EMPLOYMENT SERVICES

Community Employment Services offers individuals the opportunity to work in the community while receiving support and supervision from staff. These services include customized job development, individualized job placement, and on-going long-term support. Prior to initiating job placement, CES staff gains knowledge about the individual's strengths, needs, abilities, and preferences. All individuals employed in community jobs are paid by their employer.

DAY HABILITATION SERVICES (COMMUNITY INTEGRATION)

This program is a compilation of comprehensive services and supports provided to adults with severe and multiple disabilities/needs. Day Habilitation assists individuals with daily living skills relating to self-care, communication, self-direction, and other areas that expand opportunities for community inclusion and self-sufficiency.

CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES

This service provides a pro-active system of support to individuals and their families through advocacy, coordination, and linkage to community resources and support services. The design of this is to promote valued roles of each person served and to be responsive to their unique multiple, and changing needs.
